

Międzyzdroje Poland

Międzyzdroje is a city and a seaside resort in northwestern Poland, in the West Pomeranian Voivodeship, on the island of Wolin on the Baltic coast.

The town is often referred to as The Pearl of the Baltic. It is situated between wide sandy beaches with high cliffs and the forests of the Woliński National Park (which includes a bison reserve). Międzyzdroje has a spa climate and is rich in tourist attractions.


The Promenade of Stars in Międzyzdroje, commonly known as Avenue of Stars, belongs to the most important tourist attractions of Międzyzdroje and the entire Polish coast. It is modeled on similar avenues in Hollywood and Cannes. There are monuments and hand prints of stars of the Polish cultural scene.


